

Common Chords of Just Intonation

All chords are based on the root "C" which is "0" pitch.

Major: C (0), E (+2), G (-14)

minor: C (0), E♭ (+2), G♭ (+16)

dim: C (0), E♭ (-17), G♭ (+16)

aug: C (0), E♯ (-4), G (-14)

7th: C (0), E♭ (-31), G (+2), B♭ (-14)

Maj7: C (0), E (-12), G (+2), B (-14)

6th: C (0), E (-16), G (+2), B♭ (-14)

m6: C (0), E♭ (+19), G (+2), B♭ (+16)
