## Instructions for Post-Baccalaureate and Post-Master's Certificates

- With your certificate program advisor, decide which courses you will take to
  fulfill the requirements for the chosen certificate. On the Program Checklist
  form, check the courses you selected and fill in the semester/year you will
  take each course.
- Certificate options within the music departments include:
  - o PBC Conducting (Choral or Instrumental Tracks)
  - o PBC Ethnomusicology
  - o PBC Historical Keyboard Performance
  - PBC Jazz Studies
  - o PBC Music Composition
  - o PBC Music Education
  - o PBC Music Performance Study
  - o PBC Music Teacher Licensure Preparation
  - o PBC Music Technology
  - o PBC Music Theory
  - o PBC Musicology
  - PMC Music Theory Pedagogy (for doctoral students only)
- For students enrolled in both a graduate degree and a certificate: courses
  that fulfill requirements in your MM or DMA/PhD Plan of Study may also
  count toward the requirements for a certificate. However, not all courses
  meeting certificate requirements may need to appear on your MM/DMA/PhD
  Plan of Study. You must complete both a POS for your degree and a
  checklist/POS for your certificate.
- Email this checklist to the School of Music Graduate Student Services office who will send it to the Graduate Program Director for approval and then send it to the Graduate School for final approval.
- Keep a copy for your records! Review this checklist each semester. If any
  changes need to be made, you should make those changes and submit an
  updated form to both the Graduate Student Services office and your advisor.
